



We now have Land Based Learning Classes for all students

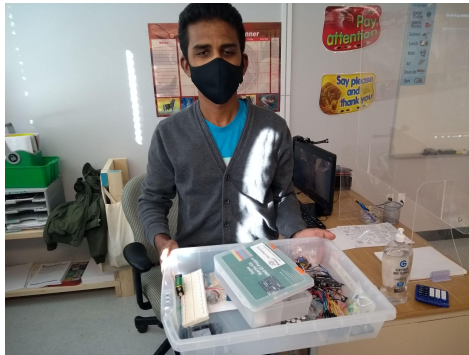

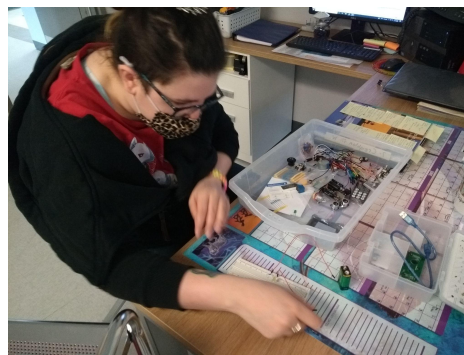


Robotics

Students will have a winter break from Monday February 14-Monday February 21. Students will return to class on Tuesday February 22.



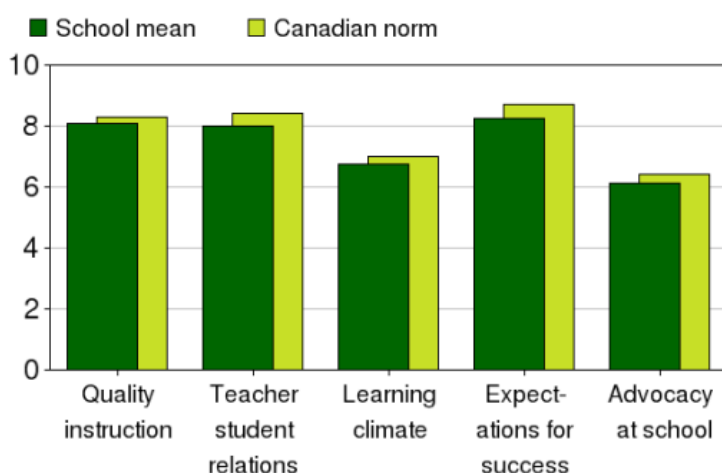


Did you know...
